Educating, Equipping, and Engaging

Pro-Life Advocacy Update

This spring brought several significant legal developments related to abortion policy and pregnancy resource centers across the country.

Supreme Court Rules in Favor of New Jersey Pregnancy Centers

On April 29, 2026, the U.S. Supreme Court unanimously ruled in favor of , a faith based pregnancy center network in New Jersey. The Court held that the organization could continue its federal lawsuit challenging a subpoena issued by the New Jersey

Attorney General seeking donor information and internal records. The justices stated that government demands for private donor information can burden First Amendment rights related to free speech and freedom of association.

While the ruling does not end the state investigation, many viewed the decision as an important victory for pregnancy centers and religious nonprofits concerned about constitutional protections and donor privacy.

Please Pray:

Pray for continued protection, wisdom, and courage for pregnancy resource centers across the country as they seek to serve women and families with truth, compassion, and integrity. Pray that ministries would remain free to share the Gospel and provide life affirming care without fear or intimidation.

Federal Update on the Abortion Pill

At the federal level, the Supreme Court also issued an emergency order on May 14, 2026, allowing mifepristone, commonly known as the abortion pill, to remain available by mail while ongoing litigation continues. The order temporarily paused lower court restrictions that would have limited mail distribution and pharmacy access. The broader legal debate surrounding abortion pill regulation remains ongoing.

Please Pray:

Pray for the protection of both mothers and unborn children, for wisdom among judges and lawmakers, and for greater awareness regarding the physical, emotional, and spiritual impacts of abortion. Pray that women facing unexpected pregnancies would encounter support, hope, and compassionate alternatives.



Massachusetts Legislative Update

Here in Massachusetts, S.1244, “An Act Enhancing Access to Abortion Care,” continues moving through the legislative process. As of May 15, 2026, the bill had been reported favorably by committee and referred to the Joint Committee on Health Care Financing for further consideration.

There are serious concerns about several provisions within the bill, including:

- Eliminating parental consent requirements for abortion

- Removing the judicial bypass process currently required in certain cases involving minors
- Reducing certain medical and safety regulations surrounding late term abortion procedures
- Limiting some conscience protections for medical professionals who object to participating in abortion related services
- Expanding state scrutiny and regulation of pro life pregnancy resource centers
- Allowing minors to consent to certain preventative medical services, including vaccinations, without parental approval
- **The most concerning language in the bill is that it would bring back the smear campaign using taxpayer funds to spread lies again about pregnancy resource centers**
- **"The department of public health shall engage in a culturally competent and linguistically diverse public education campaign to educate providers and the public about so-called crisis pregnancy centers and pregnancy resource centers, including without limitation the lack of medical services or licensed medical professionals at said centers and the availability of licensed medical and family planning services across the commonwealth".**

We encourage our supporters to stay informed, pray for wisdom for our elected leaders, and respectfully make their voices heard on issues impacting women, children, families, and the sanctity of life. If you feel led to engage, we encourage you to contact your Massachusetts legislators and share your perspective with grace, compassion, and conviction. 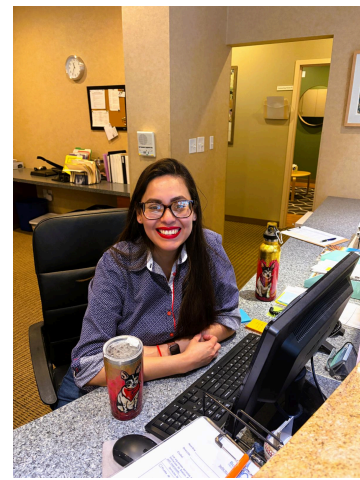
Nayeli, thank you for being such a valued part of the BPC family!

Nayeli's Why:

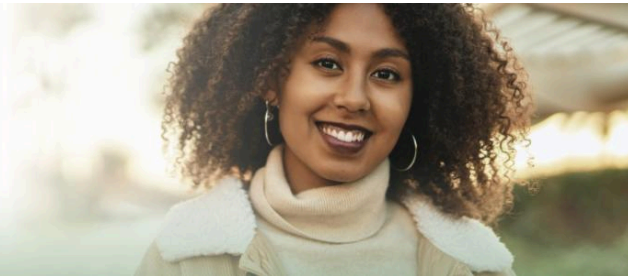
My name is Nayeli Banda, and it has been such a blessing to serve at the Boston Pregnancy Center.
